*Tips from the Professionals*

**Chipping it close**

We can't always hit the green from a long way out so we need to be able to chip it close when we don't.

1. **Stance** - Get in nice and close to the ball and narrow your feet together much closer than your full swing.
2. **Grip Down** -Grip down on the bottom of the grip this allows us way

more control as our hands are closer to the ball.

3. **Hit it like a putt** - use your shoulders to hit the ball and not your wrist this helps control the contact of the ball and gives you the same swing and result every time.
